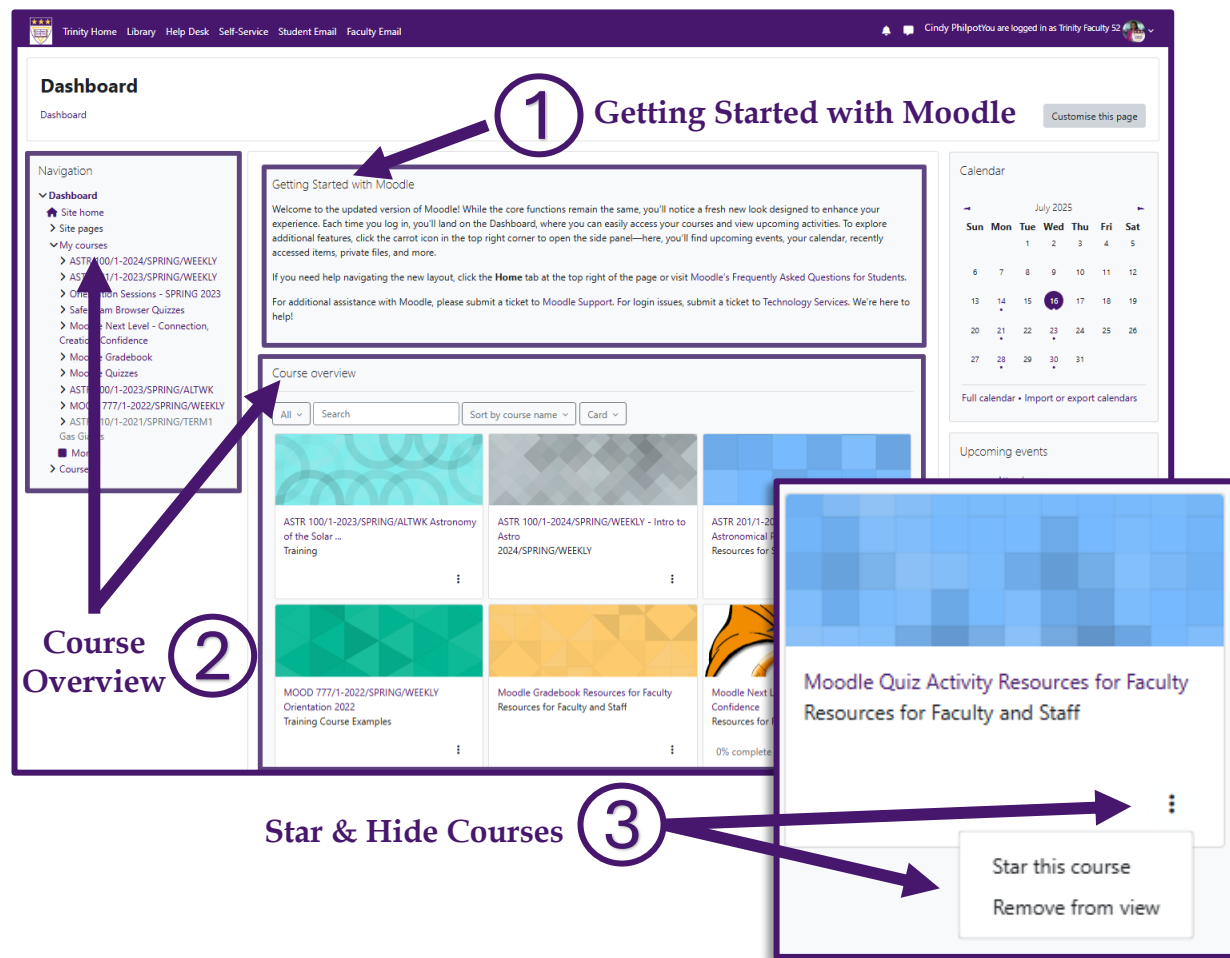


Moodle Quick Start Guide: Students

Navigating the Moodle Dashboard

①

Upon logging into Moodle, you will land on the **Moodle Dashboard**. Here, you'll find a "**Getting Started with Moodle**" block, which provides quick access to FAQs and helpful resources for students.

The **left navigation panel** has also been updated. In the **Navigation block**, you'll find links to the **Site Home**, **Dashboard**, and **My Courses**. Clicking **My Courses** will expand the tree menu to display your current course list for easy access.

Course Overview Block

②

The Course Overview block allows you to easily monitor your course progress. You can customize your view by selecting from the following options:

- All – Displays all courses
- In Progress – Shows courses currently underway
- Future – Lists upcoming courses
- Past – Displays completed courses
- Starred – Highlights courses you've marked as favorites

Use these filters to quickly find and access the courses most relevant to you.

Star and Hidden Courses

- To 'star' ('bookmark') a course click the three dots by its name and then click "Star this course".
- To hide a course, click the three dots by its name and then click "Remove from view".

3 Activities Block

Course Navigation Block

QuickMail Block

QuickMail allows students to send emails to their course participants, including instructors and other students. This box may appear just below the Navigation block in your course.

Activities Block

The Activities block lists the different activities and resources available in your course (Forums, Quizzes, Assignments, Lessons and so forth) and provides links to the index page for each activity or resource.

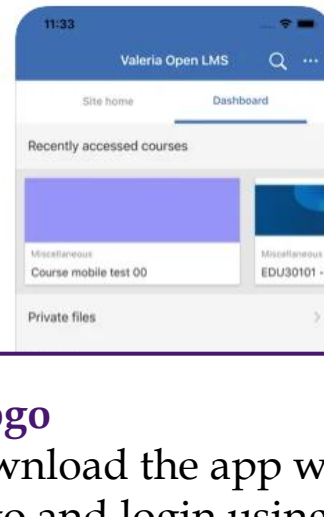
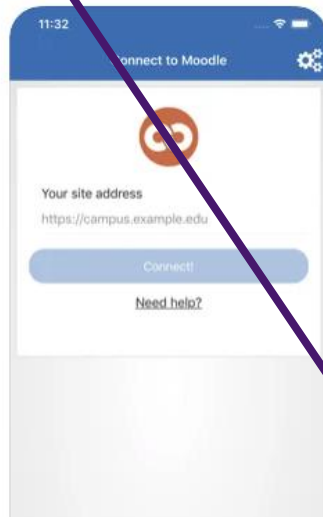
